The scholarship program is intended to provide funding for after high school education or training for women to obtain gainful employment and self-sufficiency.

Qualifications

This annual scholarship award is intended to provide funds to a registered Republican resident woman of Sheridan County, Wyoming after high school, undergraduate, or graduate graduation to attend a community college, junior college, university, or vocational trade school of her choice.

The basic scholarship criteria:

1. Age 18 years or older by April 1.
2. High school diploma or GED.
3. Registered Republican.
4. Female resident of Sheridan County
5. Planned or current attendance at a community college, junior college, university, or vocational trade school.

Funding Cycle Deadlines

Applicant Submits an Application	On or Before April 1
Board Notifies Applicant Regarding Funding Decision	On or before May 10

Applying

The scholarship program requests that you contact a member of the Republican Women of Sheridan County no less than one month prior to submitting an application to advise her of your forthcoming submission and to review the application process as needed .

Step 1:

Read the **Rules** to determine what is expected from the applicant.

Step 2:

Consult with a Republican Women of Sheridan County member no later than one month prior to submitting an application. (Member names: Melinda Brennan, Anita Schamber, Carole Perkins).

Step 3:

Download the **Application**, complete it and e-mail it back to Mrs. Brennan or print and send the copy to the Stadium Drive address.

The items below are required for any submission:

Attachment 1:

Completion of the official narrative application form sections A-G (either print and mail or complete online);

Attachment 2:

Three letters of recommendation from persons other than family members who know the applicant well and can speak to the applicant's scholarship, character, school or community involvement, etc. Please ask them to include their contact numbers for a possible follow-up telephone call and confirm sending their letters;

Attachment 3:

Copy of a most recent official high school or GED, undergraduate, or graduate transcript; and

Attachment 4:

A one-page typed essay stating the reasons the applicant should be considered for the scholarship.

Applications will be accepted on or before the due date (April 1). RWSC appreciates those that submit prior to the deadline. The successful applicant will be notified on or before May 1.
